ARTICLE II
MEMBERSHIP

Section 1.1. Regular Member

A Regular Member is defined as an individual who:

- a) is of Filipino ancestry;
- b) is a designated accountant, or a holder of university / college accounting degree or enrolled in an accounting designation program, or employed or engaged in accounting related field;
- c) has applied for membership as a Regular Member in accordance with the By-Laws and has paid the prescribed fee; and
- d) has agreed to abide by the By-Laws and rules established by the Association.

Section 2. Application for Membership

- a) Every applicant for regular membership shall complete and submit to the Association an application in the prescribed form together with the applicable membership fee.
- b) Every applicant for regular membership shall be sponsored by a Regular Member in good standing.
- c) Every application for membership shall be presented in the Executive Council's Meeting for acceptance.
- d) Membership fees for applicants who do not meet the criteria for membership will be returned to the applicants.
- e) Applicants for re-admission to membership in the Association must comply with all the requirements of this Section.

Section 3. Fees

- a) The Executive Council shall determine the annual fees to be paid by the Regular Members.
- b) Annual fees shall be billed to Regular Members not less than 30 days prior to the commencement of each calendar year and will be due and payable on the first day of each calendar year.

ARTICLE X

TERMINATION AND REINSTATEMENT OF MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Voluntary Termination of Membership

Any member may resign his membership from the Association in writing submitted to the Association's Vice president-Internal Affairs. Such resignation shall be effective as of the date fixed in said notice. The Vice President Internal Affairs shall notify the Executive Council of the resignations on a regular basis..

The membership of an Affiliate Member or an Auxiliary Member shall be automatically terminated upon the resignation or cancellation in the membership of the Regular Member, who is the spouse or partner of the Affiliate Member or Auxiliary Member.

Section 2. Involuntary Termination of Membership

A member can be terminated from the membership due to the following grounds:

1. Non-payment of dues for two (2) consecutive years except for Past Presidents;
2. Conviction of criminal offense;
3. Misrepresentation of professional status;
4. Any other justifiable grounds.

Subject to the approval of the Executive Council, any member whose dues or other accounts remain unpaid for two (2) consecutive years shall be dropped from the membership roster of the Association upon the expiration of sixty (60) calendar days from the date that notice to that effect is sent via messenger or mail.

Section 3. Reinstatement of Membership

A Regular Member who has been terminated from membership for non-payment of dues may apply for reinstatement of membership through a written notice addressed to the President and subject to the approval of the Executive Council. Such approval shall be made within thirty (30) calendar days from receipt of said notice.
